Primary.Health and California Department of Public Health Contract Amendment Proposal

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) and Primary. Health partnered to launch the CDPH Rapid Antigen testing program and have been working since April 12, 2021 with test administration, data reporting and ongoing technical support. In addition to this program, CDPH is requesting to add additional services to their current contract. The additional programs are directly related to the current contract and further support CDPH's goal of increasing testing to quickly identify individuals with COVID-19. Additional overview of the programs, associated deliverables and fees are outlined below.

Over the Counter (OTC) Binax - Test At Home Program

Using Primary.Health software, CDPH will allow organizations to offer additional testing options for rapid detection of the COVID-19 virus. In addition to antigen and molecular testing on site, this additional testing option would allow participants to test at home using the Binax OTC test and report their results through Primary.Health's platform. This will ensure that CDPH and local health departments are apprised of the health and safety of its community who prefer to test themselves in an alternative setting. This will also ensure testing is still recommended and accessible regardless of location and provided in an equitable fashion.
